Dear Beach Patrons,

We at the Pine Plains Beach are required to inform you of the following information found in the New York State Sanitary Code, Subpart 6-1 provided to us by the Dutchess County Board of Health. Along with our general rules and regulations, the following is in the interest of your safety and will be enforced.

- 1. NEVER SWIM ALONE. A minimum of two adults, 18 years of age or older, must be present whenever this swimming facility is in use. At least one of these adults must be at the beach front, and NOT in the water.
- 2. THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied to the bathing facility by a parent or guardian, or an adult who is responsible for the children and their behavior.
- 3. IN AN EMERGENCY, NOTIFY THE FACILITY OPERATOR AND CONTACT HELP IMMEDIATELY. A free telephone is provided at this facility (inside the beach house). Telephone numbers for the nearest emergency medical service are posted.
- 4. Only use this facility during posted hours of operation.
- 5. DON'T DRINK ALCOHOL AND SWIM. Alcohol is not allowed in the recreation area.
